Ongo® presents its mobile workplace concept at Workspace 2021 in Paris

The ONGO® workplace concept intuitively and optimally unites both aspects of ‘wooving’. The different furniture elements invite workers simply to take their own workplace with them or to conveniently convert it depending on task, project or team. Whether to hold a spontaneous meeting, create a quiet corner to get to grips with a tricky task or to gain a fresh perspective for creative thinking. In just a few minutes, the Ongo® modules enable



workplaces to be organised exactly as required at any given moment, creating the very best conditions for productive work.

The three pillars of the concept

The Ongo® workplace concept will be launched at Workspace 2021 in Paris, Europe's second largest trade fair for office furniture. It is based on three pillars: active sitting, mobile desks and the pop-up office. Often, it is the small details that bring about big changes – for instance, stools, chairs and tables that can be hydraulically adjusted from sitting to standing height. The Spark desk with its convenient stool hook for simple and spontaneous workplace movement whenever a team meeting is called. A mobile meeting table with space for three ONGO® stools that enables straightforward use wherever required. A range of mobile privacy and noise control boards, which can also be used as notice boards, pin boards and monitor units for video conferences. And finally, the Ongo® Wing, the first sit-stand office chair in the world.

Workspace will take place from 5 to 7 October at the Paris Expo Porte de Versailles. The ONGO® workplace concept will be presented at booth N59 in hall 7.2 (at Ergonoma Journal).
